Come explore the beauty of autumn in Rocky Mountain National Park. This 5-day program will be held during one of the most extraordinary times of the year in the northern Colorado Rockies. Fall is when the elk gather by the hundreds in and around town during the annual rutting season, and the aspen trees are bursting with color. After an initial day of 4X4 jeep outings in the high country around Estes Park, participants will learn to outwit local trout with fly fishing guides and hike some of the renowned trails in and around the Estes Valley. During the evenings, recover and relax while soaking in outdoor hot tubs, counting the stars and enjoying the sound of bugling bull elk.
